1. **Maharashtra** government will provide the financial grant of **1,000 rupees per quintal** to those farmers whose tur and gram could not be purchased by the administration before the May 31 deadline.
2. In **Uttarakhand**, Polythene will be completely prohibited from **31st July in the state**.
3. The **Madhya Pradesh** government has announced an outstanding power bill waiver scheme for labourers and poor families.
4. The **Indian Railway Catering and Tourism Corporation (IRCTC)** introduced the trial run of environment friendly bagasse-based food packaging on **8 premium trains like Shatabdis and Rajdhani originating from New Delhi**.
5. **Maharashtra Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis** inaugurated a web portal named **Continuous Medical Education (CME)** to offer information and suggestions related to exact treatment received by patients for various health issues.
6. Minister of State (IC) for Power and New & Renewable Energy, **R K Singh** chaired the **'Review, Planning and Monitoring (RPM) Meeting'** with the Secretaries of Power/Energy Departments of the States/UTs and Managing Directors of the Power Utilities.
7. The Indian government has formed a group to study the **Special Economic Zones (SEZ) Policy of India, headed by Baba Kalyani**.
8. The 11th edition of **Geo-Intelligence Asia 2018** was organized at **Manekshaw Centre in New Delhi**.
9. The state government of **Bihar** launched new **crop insurance scheme**.
10. **Uttar Pradesh** government to set up police station in every district
11. **China** has approved the first domestically developed, long-acting injectable HIV drug named **Albuvirtide**.
12. Monetary Policy Committee (MPC) of Reserve Bank of India has increased the policy **Repo Rate** under the liquidity adjustment facility (LAF) **by 25 basis points to 6.25 percent**

13. IDFC Bank received RBI's approval for merger of **Capital First, Capital First Home Finance** and **Capital First Securities** with the company
  14. **World Bank** approved an amount of **Rs. 6000 crore** for the implementation of **Atal Bhujal Yojana**.
